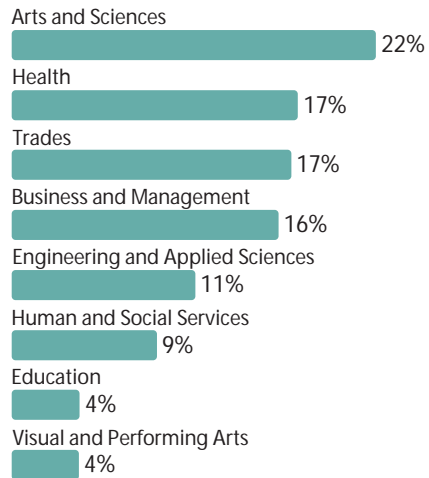
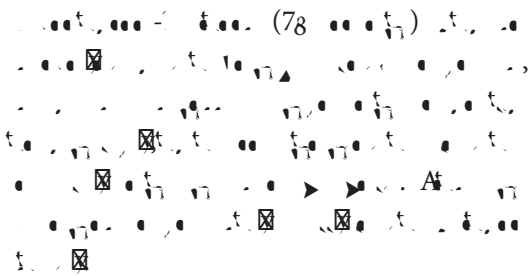


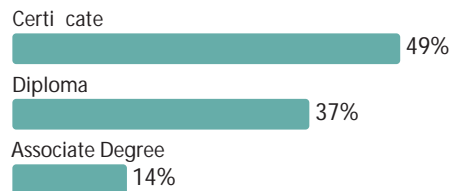
In 2014, 28,268 students completed a program, and 14,357 students completed a diploma or certificate program. The majority of students (55%) completed a diploma or certificate program. The majority of students (92%) completed a program in the following categories:

Note: Programs are grouped using the BC CIP Cluster, a roll-up based on the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP).

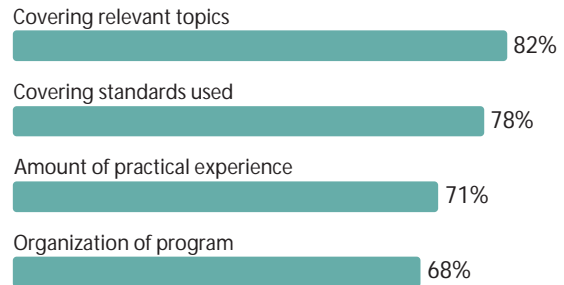
A majority of students (49%) completed a certificate program, followed by diploma (37%) and associate degree (14%).



Note: Associate Degree includes university transfer.

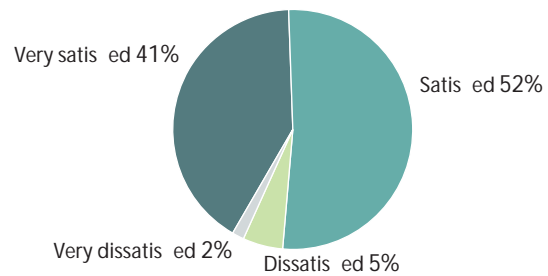
## Evaluations

82% (5 or 4) of respondents said that the program covered relevant topics. 78% of respondents said that the program covered standards used. 71% of respondents said that the program provided an amount of practical experience. 68% of respondents said that the program was well organized.



Note: Percentages are of those who said the content of their education was *very good* or *good*, based on respondents who gave a rating, excluding those who said *not applicable*. A five-point scale (from *very good* to *very poor*) was used.

41% of respondents said they were very satisfied with the program. 52% of respondents said they were satisfied. 5% of respondents said they were dissatisfied. 2% of respondents said they were very dissatisfied.



## Funding

52% of respondents who borrowed said they used combined borrowing. 26% of respondents who borrowed said they used government student loans. 37% of respondents who borrowed said they used loans from other sources. The median loan amount for combined borrowing was \$10,000, for government student loans it was \$11,000, and for loans from other sources it was \$5,000.

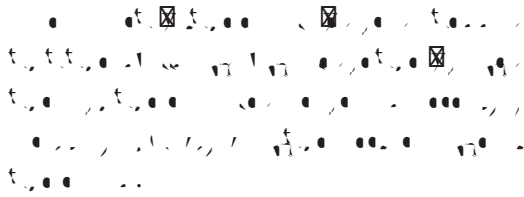

## Further studies

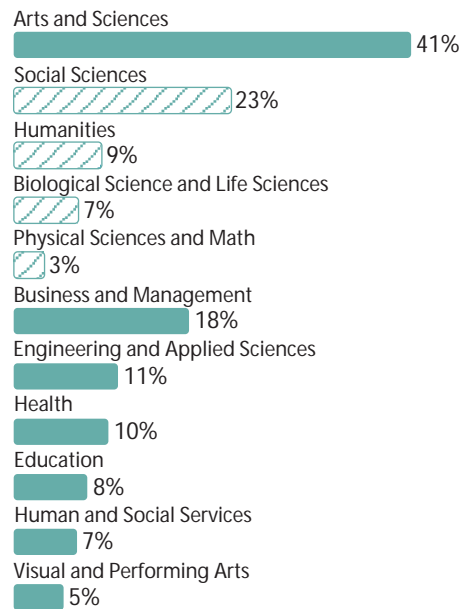
65% of respondents said they would like to attend further studies. 71% of respondents said they would like to attend further studies.

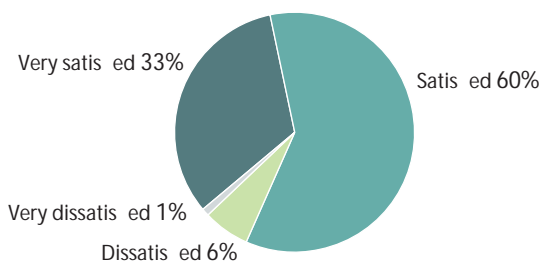
## Evaluations

Quality of instruction was rated very good or good by 94% of respondents. Core program courses were rated very good or good by 89% of respondents. 74% of respondents said they would take the program again.



Note: Percentages are of those who said the instruction and courses were very good or good, based on respondents who gave a rating, excluding those who said not applicable. A four-point scale (from very good to very poor) was used. The percentage of those who said they would take the same program again is based on all respondents.

Very satisfied 33%, Satisfied 60%, Dissatisfied 6%, and Very dissatisfied 1%.

Total financial debt was \$22,000.

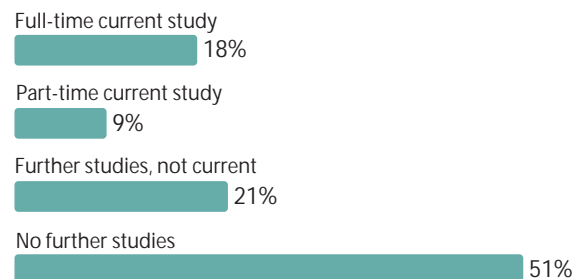

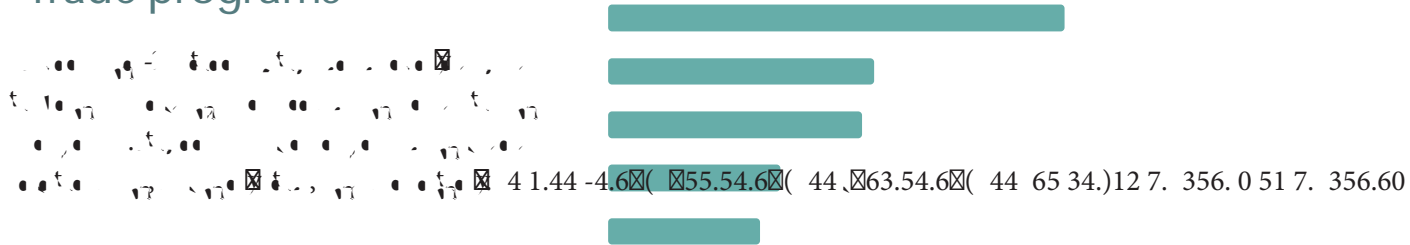

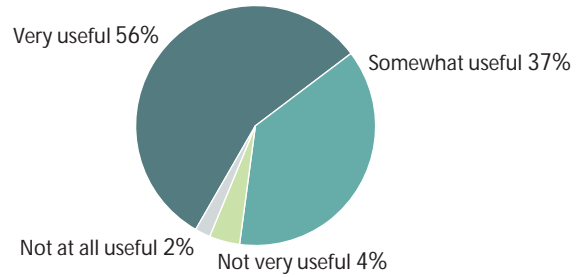

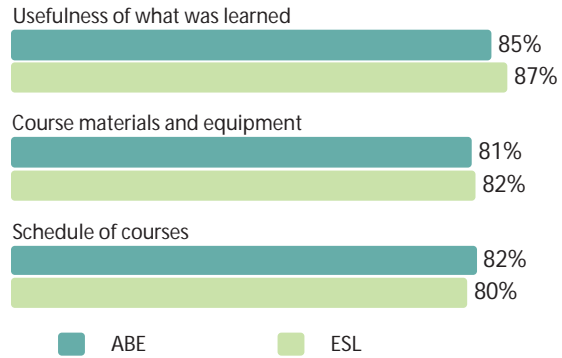

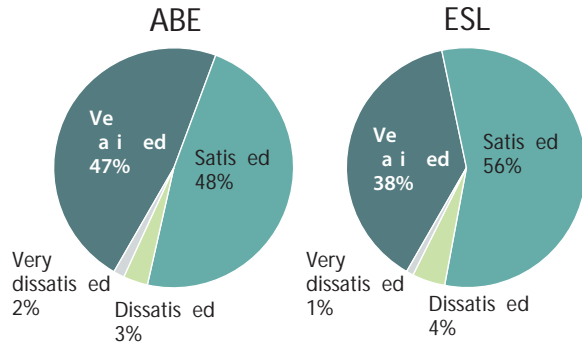
## Evaluations

After (700+) the ABE program, students were surveyed about their satisfaction with various aspects of the program. The survey results are shown in the following bar chart.



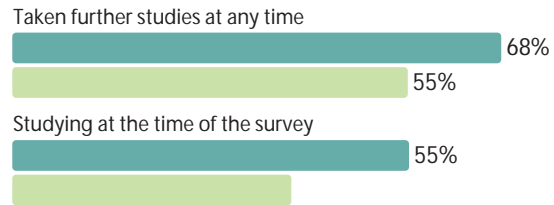

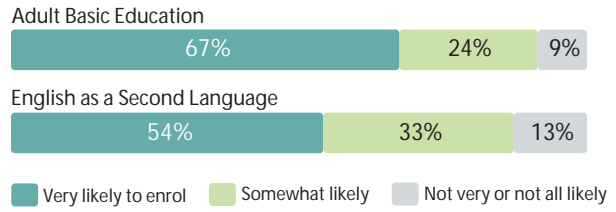
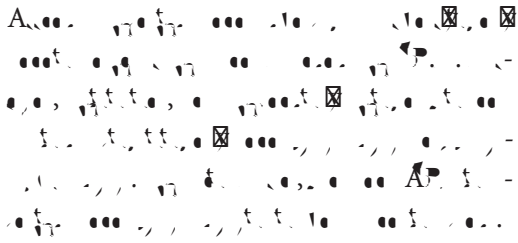
