## Can I apply for my temporary resident visa (TRV, aka entry visa) and study permit extension at the same time?

No. You must first apply for study permit extension. If it's approved, then you can apply for TRV from inside Canada.

I have changed post-secondary schools, and I transferred to Okanagan College. What do I need to do?

You must notify the IRCC that you have changed school. ## I am a high school student with a study permit. Do I need to apply for another study permit?

If your study permit is still valid and does <u>not</u> restrict you from moving between school levels or studying at post-secondary level, you don't need to change or apply for a new study permit if you're moving from high school to post-secondary. If your study permit will expire, you need to apply to extend it.
